We are excited to make plans for our football, soccer, and volleyball athletes this fall. Like the many other aspects of returning to school, there are specific guidelines that will be new to our community and will require everyone's cooperation in order to have a safe and successful season.

MHSAA guidelines limit spectators that allowed at all events. Each athlete involved will receive two tickets. Knowing the support that our student-athletes receive, we understand the difficulty that this will cause and apologize for not being able to make further allowances.

It is our hope that we will be able to find ways for families to digitally access the games from home. Further guidance will be coming regarding the entry process for home and away events.

With the announcement of fall athletics, MHSAA provided specific rules for spectator attendance at athletic events. Those attending events must comply with all MHSAA guidelines.

- EVERYONE must wear a mask at all times.
- Families may sit together, but non-family members must be six feet apart.
- Hosting school districts will be expected to ensure that these rules are followed. Unfortunately, if spectators choose not to comply, they will be asked to leave. Failure to comply may result in the suspension or cancellation of the game.

After the cancellation of our spring season, we believe that we can easily comply with these guidelines so that our students can play. This fall will be unique and we expect a few bumps along the way. However, I have full confidence that we can make this fall successful as we work together for our kids and provide them with a positive athletic experience.
