Dear Parents/Guardians:

I am writing to inform you that due to the potential exposure of multiple staff members to COVID-19, List Elementary will be closed at the direction of the Saginaw County Health Department (SCHD) on September 28, 29, and 30. Classes will resume for everyone as normal on Thursday, October 1. The SCHD currently believes that the staff exposures have not resulted in any student illness or cases.

During this time, staff members will be quarantined, and with the cooperation of the Saginaw County Health Department, have arranged testing to ensure staff are healthy when in-person instruction resumes. The SCHD will be in touch with additional information, if necessary, providing continued guidance for the District. Our Eagle Express and the List Elementary Preschool will remain open during this time period, under direction from the SCHD.

Cleaning and disinfecting of all exposed areas will be completed. The school is also taking precautions to prevent the introduction and spread of viruses and other germs and is cleaning frequently touched surfaces daily. The status of this situation is fluid, and we are monitoring it closely.

Students in grades K-4 will continue their education through online methods (as practiced during our “all-virtual Fridays”) on September 28, 29, and 30. Teachers will communicate with families the expectations and opportunities for learning for their respective classes.

We ask that all parents continue to be on the lookout for the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in your child. Symptoms can include but are not limited to **fever, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, sore throat, headache, diarrhea, vomiting and abdominal pain**. If any of these occur, we ask you to keep your student home. We encourage you to contact your healthcare provider to discuss testing or management of any symptoms that develop. Should you want your child to be tested you can call 2-1-1, or your healthcare provider may order a test.

As always, we appreciate our community’s support and cooperation. You can assist us by remaining vigilant but sensible in your approach to dealing with this health concern. Practice the **3 Ws**: (**W**ash your Hands, **W**ear a Mask, and **W**atch your Distance).
