Dear Frankenmuth School District Parents and Community,

I have said numerous times that I am grateful for the flexibility our families, students, and community have demonstrated since March as we have continued to make plans with the best information available at the time decisions need to be made. This gratitude continues today because one thing we know for sure is that the information – and the plans that rely on that information – change rapidly, so we must be nimble and prepared to pivot as changes come. I am writing to share that we need to pivot yet again and I am sorry because I know that continued changes, especially after plans are in place, cause additional hardships.

Our intention with the information that was sent out Friday was to provide families with the ability to plan ahead. After hearing yesterday's state-wide update from the Governor and Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and consulting with the Saginaw County Health Department again, we are altering our plans. Beginning Thursday, December 10, 2020, The Frankenmuth School District will resume face-to-face instruction for our preK-8 "in-person" learners. Per the existing orders, classes for grades 9-12 will continue to be held remotely.

Our foodservice will continue to provide meals daily for pick up for "all-virtual" learners, as well as high school students, from 11:00 AM – 2:00 PM daily at the FHS Concessions Stand.

We thank you for your flexibility, your patience, your understanding, and your continued support of our efforts to make the most of any in-person instructional time we can get, and we ask that you continue to do your part by staying home if you're ill, washing your hands, wearing a mask, and watching your distance. We will continue to closely monitor this unprecedented situation and do our best to nimbly navigate it and communicate any changes with you.
